HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

 - 5.2 Ensure the systematic identification of hazards and the assessment and control of risk.
 - 5.3 Allocate appropriate resources (e.g. human resources, financial resources, training resources etc.).
 - 5.4 Promote a positive health and safety culture which secures the full participation of all members of the organisation in achieving high standards of health, safety and welfare throughout the Trust.
- The Health and Safety Policy will be reviewed every three years or whenever a change necessitates this.
